

Indiana Chapter of the IASIU SIU Investigator of the Year

The Indiana Chapter of the IASIU SIU investigator of the year award is presented to a chapter member of the Indiana Chapter of the IASIU who has shown exceptional accomplishments in the area of insurance fraud investigation, fraud prevention or fraud detection. Nominees for this award are assessed based on their contributions to the Indiana Chapter, the International Association of Special Investigation Units (IASIU), the insurance fraud investigation profession, and their impact on the community or the profession.

An Awardee would need to demonstrate outstanding achievements in various areas. These achievements might include:

1. Contributions to the Indiana Chapter: The awardee should have made significant contributions to the local chapter by actively participating in chapter events, serving on committees, or holding leadership positions.
